

Vedder Middle School Dress Code 2017/2018

Expectations

Students should dress sensibly in clothing that is appropriate to the school or work setting. The dress code includes the following but is not limited to these guidelines:

- No hats are to be worn in school.
- No bandanas may be worn or displayed in any way.
- No bare feet.
- No bare midriffs (bellybuttons.)
- No halter tops.
- No spaghetti straps, exposed underwear, or exposed bra straps.
- No very tight or revealing clothing.
- no short shorts or short skirts:
- Hemlines must be lower than the student's extended fingertips when their relaxed arms are placed to the side of their body.
- No articles of clothing bearing vulgar, discriminatory or derogatory messages or images.
- No articles of clothing bearing drug or alcohol related messages or images.
- Shirts must have a neckline to sufficiently cover the entire chest area (no cleavage).
- Pants are to be worn around the waistline making sure underwear is not exposed.
- No muscle shirts are to be worn.

Consequence

If clothing is inappropriate, the student will be required to change into something which is appropriate.
