# One School One Book project: poster

Due date: January 31st (or any day earlier)

- poster is done on  $30 \times 45$  cm. manilla tag (available in the library)
- poster theme is anything you choose from POPPY (a scene, a character, a chapter, a theme, etc)
- the best posters are multi-medium and use different types of materials, layering, and techniques (i.e. paint, wool, tinfoil, sparkle, fabric, crayons, etc)
- do not leave any blank spaces where manilla tag shows through, cover the entire surface
- you must have the title of the book and your name clearly visible on the front of the poster
- you can work individually or with a partner

# One School One Book project: graphic novel

<u>Due date: January 31st</u> (or any day earlier)

- take a scene or chapter from POPPY and create it in graphic novel format
- the graphic novel templates are available in the library
- do not leave any blank spaces of white on your graphic template
- you must have the title of the book and your name clearly visible on your work
- the length of the project is up to you, a single page or a whole booklet
- you can work individually or with a partner

# One School One Book project: relief map of the Dimwood Region

<u>Due date: January 31st</u> (or any day earlier)

- use the map at the beginning of POPPY, and create a relief map of the Dimwood Region
- you will probably need to research different ways of building a relief map (Pinterest has tons!)
- you can use lego, playdoh/modelling clay, paper, plaster of paris, materials from nature, or.....?
- the materials for this project will not be provided at school. You will need a large, strong base
- label the different parts of Dimwood region on your relief map
- you can work individually or with a partner
- have fun, be creative, show us what Dimwood looks like in 3-D

# One School One Book project: dance presentation <u>Due date: January 31<sup>st</sup></u> (or any day earlier)

- you must be a dancer in order to choose this project
- create a dance that you would be willing to present at our assembly
- the dance is your interpretation of what you envision Poppy's dancing would look like or another dance theme from the book
- of course, it must be choreographed and set to music
- you may perform individually or with a partner

# One School One Book project: iMovie book trailer Due date: January 31<sup>st</sup> (or any day earlier) Criteria:

- create a POPPY iMovie book trailer on a school ipad. When you open the iMovie app, choose "trailer"
- the length of the movie should be minimum 30 seconds and maximum 1 minute
- your iMovie should have book title and author at the beginning, a theme, and credits at the end
- your iMovie should be engaging, with music, scenes from the book, imagery, graphics, etc.
- you can work individually or with a partner
