Mural Committee Report

Surveys:

- Have gone out, 39 responses digitally, paper surveys are due March 1
- People will be reminded on Movie Night to fill out those surveys and check out the mural presentation
- Once the survey has been submitted we will use those results to give to Carrie-Lynn some ideas, she will do with them what she wants as she has artist autonomy

Budget:

- The budget is being worked on, expect the mural to be around \$8,000-\$10,000
- We have received the \$3,000 Indigenous grant
- The grant will be used as the deposit, once we get more grants we can use those to help with the final payment after the mural is complete
- Deirdre O'C. and Jessie K. will work on trying to get more grants to reduce the overall cost
- A contract will be drafted between the school and Carrie-Lynn
- If grant money comes in after PAC pays for the mural, it can be documented that the money is going back to the PAC if it is delayed in being received
- Motion: by Jessie K. to spend up to \$7000 on the mural project, seconded by Carli B., PASSED (unanimous)

Ongoing Business

Grade 5 Grad

- Ms. Austin and Mrs. Hayes have asked for \$500-\$550 for year-end grad treats and activity day to support 50 students
- We have budgeted this in our year end celebrations, we would like to offer \$600
- Motion: by Jessie K. to spend \$600 for Grade 5 year end activity and treats, seconded by Karina C., PASSED (unanimous)

New Business

- Kindness project: to make a tree in the hallway outside the library where students add hearts with messages of kindness and see it grow as they add hearts
